Post Heart Cath. Update,

I hope this makes it to everyone before 5 p.m. Blake is back in his room and resting comfortably...without a breathing tube! We are relieved to say that the doctors were able to extubate Blake once the procedure was completed, and before bringing him back to his room.

Results of the heart cath. will be discussed with the heart surgeons Monday. The cath. showed multiple VSD's as we expected in the lower portion of the heart between the right and left ventricles. This can be a difficult area to repair. We'll wait to hear from the team as to what our options are and timing of the surgery. We are pleased Blake is back in his room and resting. Thank you all for your thoughts and prayers...and we will send more information when we can.

For now...let's all keep an eye on 'Rita'. Of course, everyone is welcome in Austin this weekend. Take care of yourselves and your families.
